VISIT TO LE TOUQUET SEPTEMBER 2016

Members of the Association went to Le Touquet in September to join in with the celebrations for the town's 50th anniversary of being twinned with Winterberg in Germany. Eleonore writes 'As always we were received with smiles and welcoming words from our Le Touquet twinning friends as we arrived on Friday 25th September. Le Touquet looked very elegant and vibrant as we drove in and to our surprise the Centre Leonce Duprez where we would meet for the next two days had been refurbished and repainted and now has a state of the art kitchen. All of which added to our delight in being part of the Winterberg celebrations. Our Mayor and his family stayed on at the CLD while Mike was hosted by Marie-Helene and Patrick Lorand, and Eleonore and Tony by Yvette Debailleul in their respective lovely villas.

Saturday was a very busy day, starting with a visit to the covered market, with a quick trip to the Carrefour for Eleonore and Tony so they could stock up on wine and confits de canard!

The formal reception at the Town Hall presided over by Kate Landry-Madden was very impressive. Speeches from the Mayor of Winterberg stressed the strong alliance it has had for the past 50 years and still has with Le Touquet. The Belgian representative said a few words and our Mayor Chris Holliday added to the festivities with a short but warm and witty speech. The Mayor of Le Touquet Mr Daniel Fasquelle addressed the twinning groups with words of welcome and congratulations after which the signing of a renewed contract between the towns of Winterberg and Le Touquet took place.



Our Mayor presented Mr Fasquelle with a framed photo of the Buttercross in Witney and Mike presented him with beer from our Wychwood brewery to replace the beer that was dropped on the floor during the official part of the Twin Town Challenge 2016! Mr Fasquelle was delighted.

In the afternoon we had a guided tour of Le Touquet which was highly appreciated by those who had not been there before and for those who had, it was wonderful to reacquaint ourselves with this very English French town! We followed our beach stop by visiting the 'Manufacture du Touquet Biscuits et Gourmandises' where we were treated to a special demonstration from the chef pâtissier. The biscuits were delicious and the whole place smelled of spices and buttery pastry. Divine!

In the evening after drinks on the terrace of the CLD we sat down to a meal especially prepared for us by the town's designated chef. Needless to say it was 'haute gastronomie' all around!

On Sunday we were treated to a special tour of the magnificent villas in the forest area of Le Touquet, thanks to Marie-Helene and Patrick Lorand who also showed us the impressive hippodrome complex and last but not least the Baie de Canche near the Nautical Centre.
